Ditholwana Ts'a Rena Community Development Trust (DTRT) is pleased to announce the water Support Project Funding Call for applications for the 2026. DTRT hereby invite registered organisations which operates as ECD centres, non-profit organisations and community facilities in Mapela and Mokopane that experience ongoing water shortages or interruptions.

- The purpose of this support is to help facilities access a more reliable on-site water supply so that education, care and community services can operate without frequent disruption. The support includes the following:
- The drilling and installation of a borehole;
- The installation of JoJo water storage tanks;
- Basic water reticulation and safety measures.

The Trust will assess proposed sites and, where feasible and approved.

Support will only be provided to sites that pass a technical and governance feasibility assessment and receive the necessary approvals. This support is not a cash grant.

The following organisations are legible to apply:

- Registered ECD centres;
- Registered non-profit organisations;
- Community facilities that provide shared education, care or social services.
- Applicants must be located in Mapela or Mokopane.

Minimum requirements

Applicants must be able to show that:

- They have permission to use the land (have a valid PTO) where the borehole and tanks would be installed, including approval from the landowner or traditional authority where applicable;
- There is a responsible person or committee who will oversee and look after the water system;
- They are willing to maintain the system and follow agreed rules for use;

- They are available to participate in site assessments and engage with local authorities if required.

Selection process

All applications will be reviewed and assessed for:

- Technical feasibility, including groundwater potential;
- Land and legal permissions;
- Long-term sustainability and basic maintenance arrangements;
- The number of people who will benefit.

Only sites that meet the minimum requirements and pass the feasibility assessment will be supported. A maximum of 15 sites will be selected.

Important information

Submitting an application does not guarantee approval or installation.

The Trust may decline applications that do not meet feasibility or governance requirements.

Ditholwana Ts`a Rena Trust reserves the right to allocate funds according to its priorities. No applicant is automatically entitled to funding. All funding is at the discretion of the Ditholwana Ts`a Rena Trust.

How to apply

Proposals outlining the number of beneficiaries, location of the organisation, the organisations profile **(which includes but not limited to; brief background and history of the organization, organisational structure (organogram), resources, contact details including physical location and other relevant information)** and outline of the organisational need for water.
